

Terry Deno opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m.

Mark Davies presented the Community Assembly Report:

A Water Conservation Discussion for District 3 will be hosted by District 3 Council Reps on Feb. 4, 2021 at 6PM via WebEx.

Regarding the Crosswalks at Barnes Rd. and Farmdale, it was suggested that Bump Outs be used to help slow traffic coming down the Barnes Road hill. But because of the blind intersection it was recommended that flashing crossing lights and signs be installed.

A question concerning the development of Meadowglen Park was asked. No action has been taken to develop it yet. City Council Rep Cathcart is the new Rep to the Parks Board and has been made aware of the situation with our undeveloped park and the need for developing it. Parks Board is to develop a 6-year plan for parks.

District 3 Town Halls will be in June at the regularly scheduled City Council meetings. North Indian Trail is scheduled for June 14th at West Central if virus restrictions are lifted and via WebEx if not.

Jeanine McKinney gave the Treasurer's report:

The grant money from the City was received for our Zoom Account in the amount of \$163.24.

The Balance in the account is \$7,034.53.

Karen Stratton gave a City Council up-date. She noted some Initiatives the Council is working on now.

They are working with the Legal Dept, County, and Code Enforcement to better process derelict homes.

They want to cease the houses, clean them up, and use them for affordable housing.

They accepted a Grant from the Dept. of Commerce for funding towards a Young Adult Shelter. Ages 18-24.

Community Housing and Human Services are working with a group of builders and developers on plans for Affordable Housing.

Annica Eagle spoke about the Neighborhood Clean Up Program.

There had to be adjustments to the Program in 2020 due to the Covid Pandemic. North Indian Trail received 133 dump passes in Oct. The Clean Up is still being affected by Covid. It will be reevaluated in Fall. They are looking at other ways to work through and improve the Program.

There will be a 2021 Comprehensive Plan Amendments Training Session offered on January 28 at 5:30 P.M. Via WebEx.

An election was held to extend the position of Chairman for 1 year. With no objections Terry Deno was approved by vote to continue as Chairman . There will be another election held in June to for the other officers.

Adam Swinyard from Spokane Public Schools gave a presentation on the upcoming 2021 Replacement Levy Election. The election will take place on February 9th. It will cover the next 3 years.

He spoke about the difficult challenges the schools have faced during the Pandemic.
