

Terry Deno opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m.

He reminded everyone of the Fall Curbside Pickup scheduled for tomorrow morning.

Jeanine McKinney reported a balance of \$6,587.45 in our account.

The price to file the appeal of the Land Use Decision at the September 28<sup>th</sup> Hearing was \$338.48.

\$249 was taken from the NITNC account. Jeanine added \$89.48 from her personal account to meet the required amount. A motion was made to reimburse Jeanine for the money she added. A vote was taken and the vote was unanimous to reimburse her \$89.45.

Mark Davies gave the Community Assembly Report.

The combined CA / CC meeting was on September 29 via Zoom . Unfortunately, only 1 City Council member attend and one staff assistant. Both had to leave early right after their presentation so no questions got asked or answered. This was the poorest showing by city council in over the 5 years I have been attending and seems to generally reflect the city's lack of support for the neighborhoods.

There will be a meeting on October 20th on the planned use of Community Development Block Grant funds (CDBG) at West Central Community Center from 4:00 to 5:30 pm. The city has been cited by the Federal Government for not using the funds in a timely manner and stand to loose these funds and future funds due to lack of timeliness. It appears from the new directors comments, that all the work done at the District levels is being ignored or cast aside due to the lack of timeliness. I encourage all NC Presidents and District reps attend this meeting.

The Gonzaga School of Leadership will be conducting the Spokane Neighborhood Leadership Academy again next year. Information sessions will be held October 17 and November 14 6:30-7:30 pm at the NorthEast Community Center 4001 N. Cook. The actual classes dates are: January 28, February 25, March 25, April 29, May 20, and June 3. Applications will close on November 30th.

Our new Office of Neighborhood Services Representative was introduced, Annie Deasy.
